Financial Aid

Financial Aid will be available for the 2009-2010 school year. An application must be requested and completed, and a copy of your Federal Income Tax must accompany your application. No application will be considered without this important document. You will receive a letter from the Scholarship Committee upon review of your application. It is possible there will be financial aid later in the year for new enrollment, but this is not guaranteed.

Admissions Policy

East Palmyra Christian School admits qualified students on a first-come basis. Current students are given preference for early enrollment. The following are required for admissions:

- Readiness Test (k – 6) as needed
- Placement exam (7 – 12) as needed
- Admissions Application
- Registration Fee
- Tuition Contract (Agreement)
- Pastoral Reference
- Student Records
- One Personal Reference (Gr 7,8)
- Two Personal References (Gr 9 – 12)
- Home Visit—scheduled at the convenience of applying family
- Interview with Principal
- Board Approval

Visiting East Palmyra Christian School and Student Shadowing
